

TOP CHEF WINNER
OPENED
SALTO RESTAURANT IN WARSAW



Martin Gimenez Castro – the whole Poland could see his cooking talent in Top Chef – the first Polish edition of the world's most famous TV competition for professional chefs. At the end of November last year, this dear Argentinian won the title of Top Chef and the hearts of the audience.

He began his professional culinary adventure when he was 17, when he took up a job at a local restaurant. He graduated from Islas Malvinas School of Tourism, Hotel and Gastronomy in Mendoza. He built up his professional experience on many continents, e.g. he took part in the programme run by James Beard Foundation in New York. For four years, he worked at the Sale&Pepe restaurant of a well-known five-star Marco Beach Ocean Resort boutique hotel in Florida. There he met his Polish wife with whom he came to our country seven years ago.

Martin began his Polish career in Western Pomerania, where he was the head chef in Valentino – an Italian restaurant in Szczecin. Later, he moved to Warsaw, where he first opened his own restaurant in Podkowa Leśna, and later became the head chef of Hoża restaurant.

The title confirmed him in his belief that he has not had his last word in culinary matters, therefore, he decided to open his own, original SALTO restaurant. He was then invited by one of the most prestigious and exclusive hotels in the Polish Capital City, five-star Rialto, at the address of which (ul. Wilcza 73) we can now find Martin's new restaurant.
